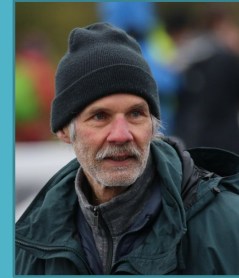

SafeSport

What is Safesport?

- The U.S. Center for SafeSport is an independent nonprofit 501 (c)(3) committed to building a sport community where participants can work and learn together free of emotional, physical and sexual abuse and misconduct.
- The U.S. Center for SafeSport was established in 2017 through the Safe Sport Authorization Act and applies to all National Governing Bodies (NGB's), such as USRowing.

SafeSport

What does SafeSport do?

- Reviews and responds to allegations of abuse and misconduct, and imposes sanctions.
- Creates and enforces policies, procedures, and training to prevent abuse and misconduct.
- Provides training to help people recognize, reduce, and respond to abuse and misconduct
- Provides confidential place to report abuse and misconduct
- Maintains a disciplinary database to keep the public informed about restrictions and sanctions

Who does SafeSport apply to at Green Lake?

- Participants
- Coaches
- Staff
- Volunteers who have direct contact with youth

SafeSport

How is SafeSport implemented?

- All coaches, staff, volunteers, and adult participants with direct contact must take training annually.

SAFESPORT

Seattle Parks and Recreation (SPR) and Associated Recreation Council (ARC) are committed to creating a safe and positive environment for athletes' physical, emotional and social development and to ensuring that it promotes an environment free of misconduct. To that end, SPR-ARC has adopted the following SafeSport Guidelines (hereinafter called "guidelines") as they relate specifically to SPR-ARC run activities at SPR boating centers. The intention of these guidelines is to promote and provide an educational environment free of misconduct.

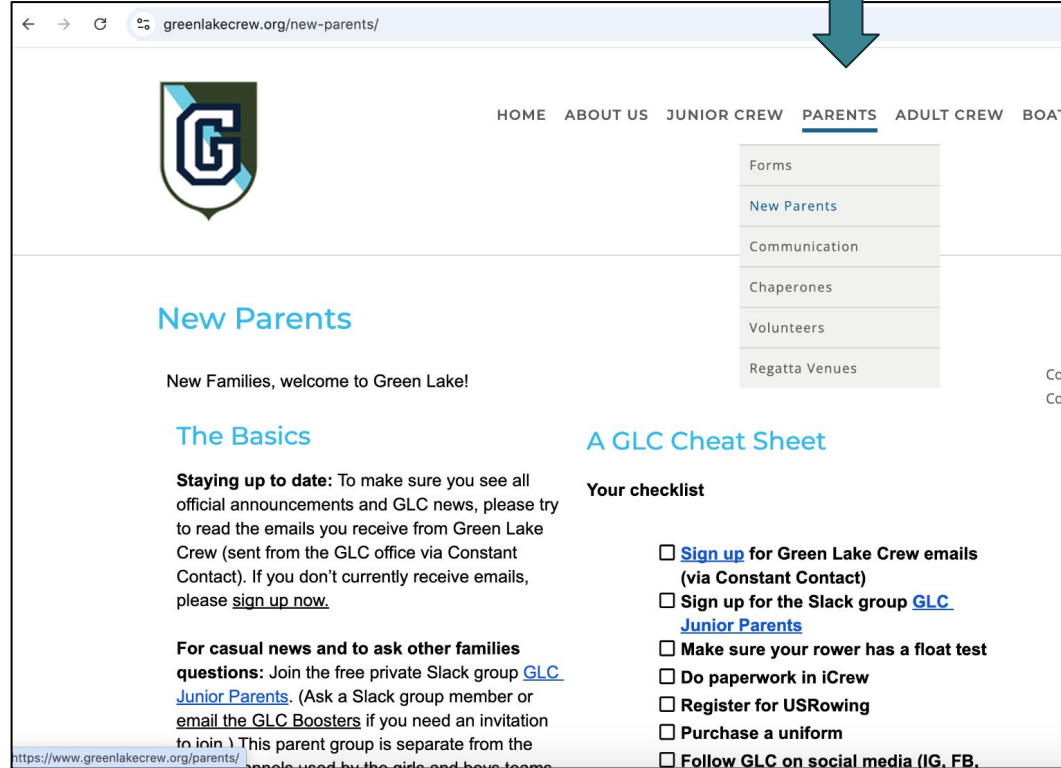
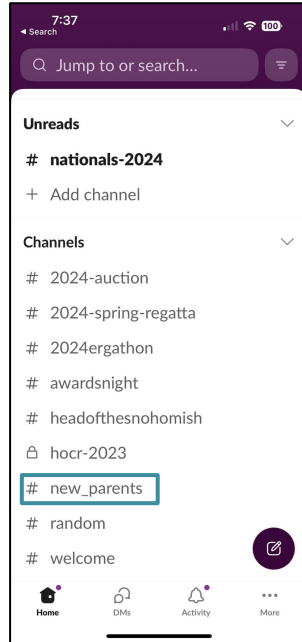

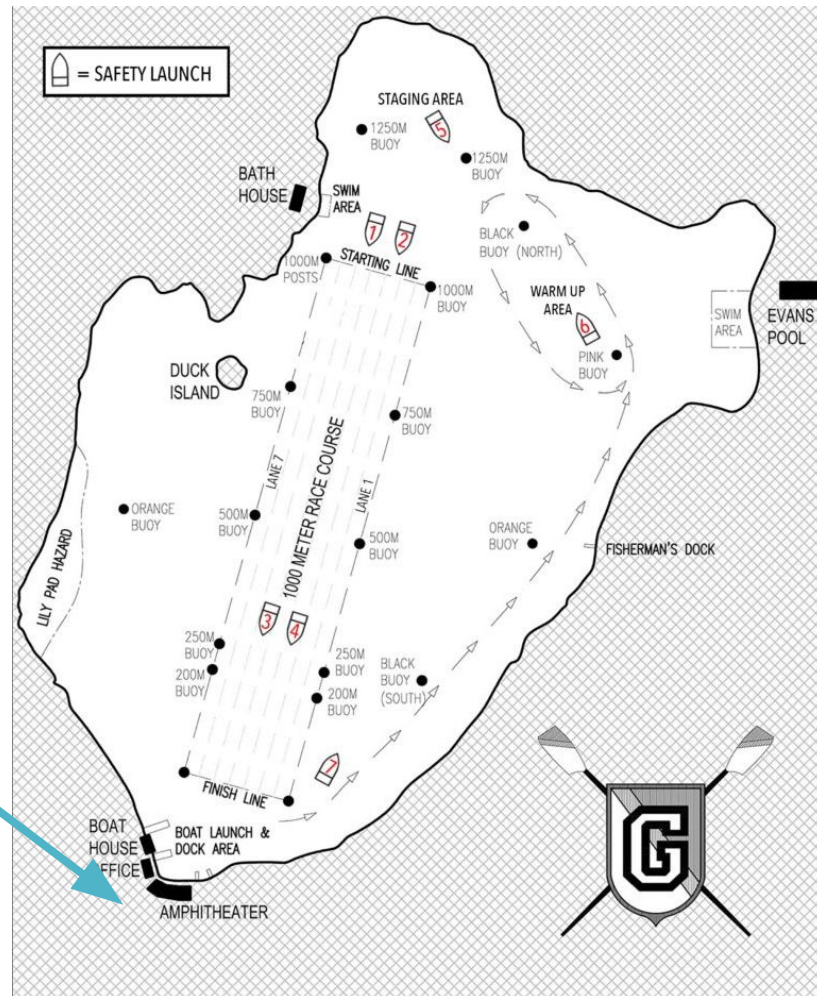
